DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Chandigarh – Shimla – Narkanda/Kotgarh (5.5 hrs)

Start your journey in the morning as you're picked up from Chandigarh Airport/Railway Station. As you head towards Narkanda, enjoy scenic views of Kufri and the snow-capped peaks in the distance. Upon arrival, check into your stay and unwind after a long day of travel. Dinner and overnight stay in Narkanda.

Day 2: Narkanda to Rakcham (6.5 hrs)

After a hearty breakfast, check out and set off towards Rakcham, a picturesque village in the Sangla Valley. On the way, take in the mesmerizing views of Rampur, Tranda Dhank, Tranda Mandir, Wangtu and Karcham. Once you arrive, check into your stay and explore the nearby surroundings at your own pace. Dinner and overnight stay in Rakcham.

Day 3: Rakcham – Chitkul – Kalpa (6.5 hrs)

Start your day with breakfast and a visit to the beautiful Baspa River and Valley. The stunning views are a treat for nature lovers. Later, continue to Kalpa, where you'll experience breathtaking views of Kinner Kailash, a sacred rock revered as the abode of Lord Shiva. Explore a local village and check into your stay for dinner and overnight in Kalpa.

Day 4: Kalpa – Khab – Nako – Tabo (7 hrs)

Enjoy breakfast before embarking on a journey to Chango. On the way, stop to marvel at the confluence of the Satluj and Spiti rivers at Khab. In Nako, take a break to explore the 11th-century monastery and the serene Nako Lake. You can also have lunch here. Continue your drive and check into your stay in Chango. Dinner and overnight stay in Chango.

Day 5: Tabo - Waterfall & Meditation

Start your day with a calming visit to the Hidden Waterfall at Tabo, where you can meditate and find inner peace in the midst of nature. Evening hike and silent meditation inside caves. The serene environment of the Tabo makes it an ideal spot for reflection and relaxation. Spend the rest of the day exploring Tabo village and its vibrant market. Dinner and overnight stay in Tabo.

Day 6: Tabo – Gue Monastery – Tabo Local

After breakfast, depart for Tabo, with a stop at the Gue Monastery to witness the ancient 500-year-old mummy of a Buddhist monk. Continue to Tabo, home to the famous 1000-year-old Tabo Monastery, often called the "Ajanta of the Himalayas." Explore the peaceful surroundings before retiring to your stay. Dinner and overnight in Tabo.

PS: China Air Distance is 1 km away from this village.

Day 7: Lidang - Kaza - Langsa - Komic - Hikkim- Tribal culture show

After breakfast, drive to Lidang, a small village in Spiti known for its rich cultural traditions. We will be doing some community service in the village. Explore some of the most iconic villages in Spiti. Visit Komic, the highest motorable village in the world, and Hikkim, home to the world's highest post office. Send a postcard to your loved ones! In Langza, you can try fossil hunting and admire the local mud craft. Witness a traditional folk dance, enjoying dinner and an overnight stay in Lidang.

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 8: Kaza - Key Monastery - Kwang nunnery (understand life of nuns) - Kaza market - Kaza

Visit to Kwang Nunnery where we will spend some time with Nuns and understand their dinchariya, before returning to Kaza for dinner and an overnight stay. Key Monastery (Key Gompa) is a renowned, 1,000-year-old Tibetan Buddhist monastery located in the Spiti Valley of Himachal Pradesh, India. Situated at 4,166 meters (13,668 ft) near the Spiti River, it is the largest, oldest, and most significant educational hub

Day 9: Kaza - Chicham Bridge - Kunzom La Pass - Chandratal Lake - Camping

After breakfast drive for Chandratal, best attraction for adventure of trekking & camping experience. On the way, visit Losar village and you can also take a tea break. Drive to Chandratal enrouting Kunzum Pass, take blessings from Kunzum Mata mandir for our better welfare. By late afternoon or evening reach Chandratal campsite and check-in to camps in the midst of overwhelming landscapes and do some hiking nearby on your own.

Later on you can go for trekking to Chandratal lake and enjoy the beautiful view of the lake. Spend some time there and enjoy the view of beautiful moon lake.

Later on come back to the camp for dinner and overnight stay under the stars and have an amazing experience of stargazing & milky-way photography shoots.

(note:- in Chandratal all camps are at the camp site and minimum 2.5- 3 kms distance from the lake - one side and don't forget to bring your camera, DSLR if you have. Otherwise you will regret it).

Day 10: Chandratal - Atul Tunnel - Manali

Begin your day with a visit to some of Manali's highlights, including Hadimba Devi Temple, Vashisht Hot Springs, and Manu Temple. Take some time to explore Old Manali and shop at the famous Mall Road.

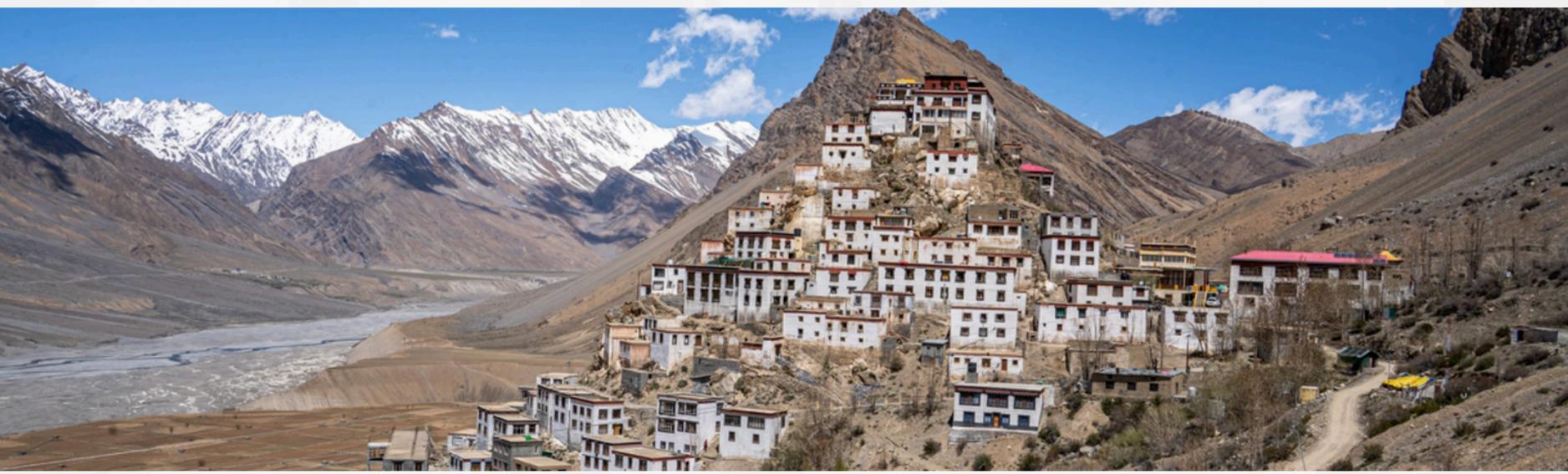
Day 11: Manali Sightseeing – Departure to Chandigarh

Manali Sightseeing. Dinner in Manali and start overnight bus journey around 10 pm

Day 12: Reach Chandigarh (early morning)

Reach Chandigarh early morning. Drop at Chandigarh airport. Beautiful trip ends here

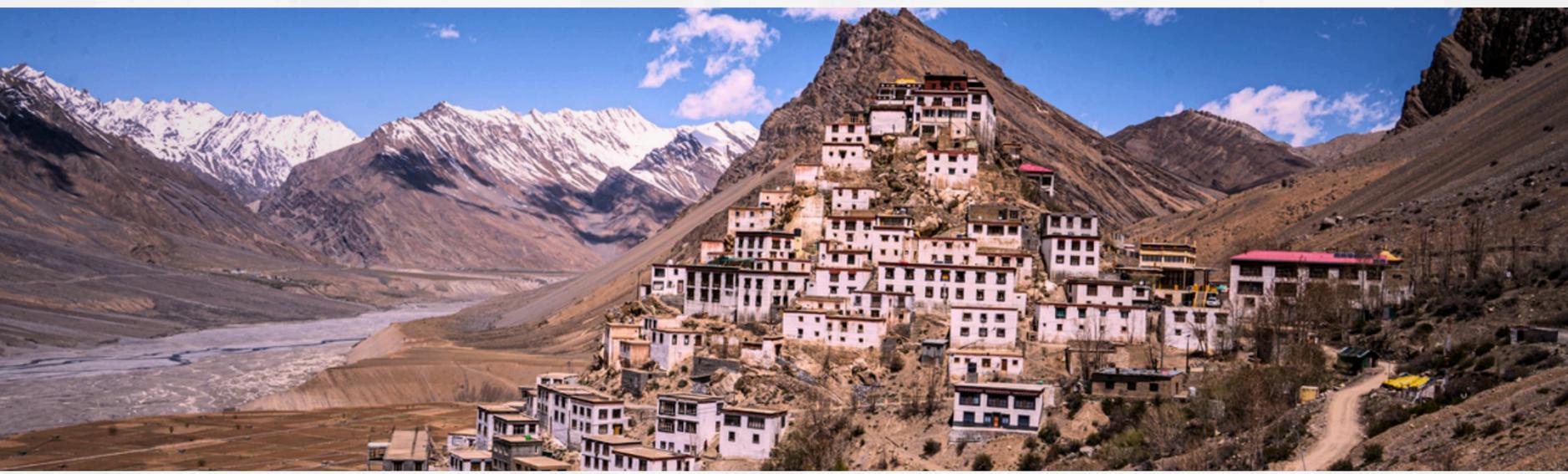

1. Agreement to Terms

By booking any Nroutes experience (long/short immersive trips, retreats, workshops, Stories on a Plate, or community gatherings), you acknowledge and agree to these Terms & Conditions, our Privacy Policy, and Refund Policy. These form a binding contract between you and Nroutes

2. Booking & Payment

- A 50% advance payment is required to secure your spot. The remaining 50% must be paid as per dates mentioned by Nroutes while sharing the details.
- Payments can be made via bank transfer, UPI, QR code or Razor Pay (details will be provided upon confirmation)
- Your registration is confirmed only after full payment is received.

3. Unforeseen Situations (Force Majeure)

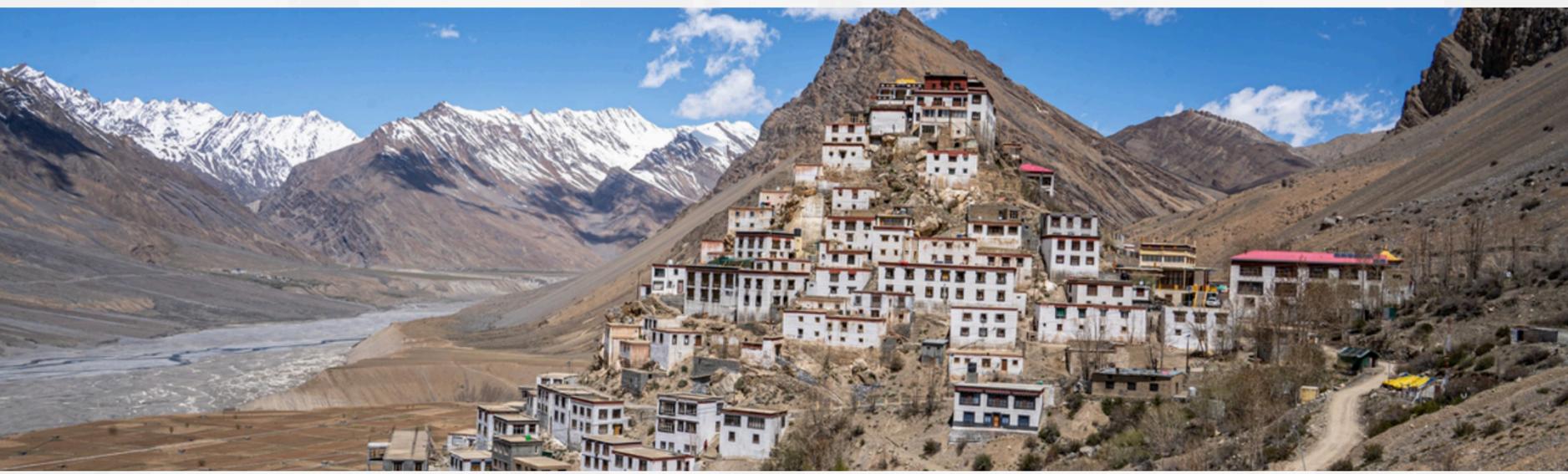
4. Health & Safety

9. Special Notes for High-Altitude/Remote Trips (Spiti, Kinnaur, Chandratal)

- Raw Destinations: Expect tribal simplicity, no luxury amenities, occasional power/water shortages, challenging roads, no network zones (Kaza-Chandratal-Manali).
- Temperatures: Daytime 20-24°C, nights 8-16°C (pack warm layers).
- Roads: Rough, winding; motion sickness preparation recommended.
- Meals: Breakfast/dinner at planned places only (no packed meals). ONLY Pure Veg/ Jain/ Vegan food served. Special dietary requests will be
- accommodated as much as possible but cannot be guaranteed.
- Limited Resources: Embrace minimalism as part of the immersion.

12. Age & Group Composition

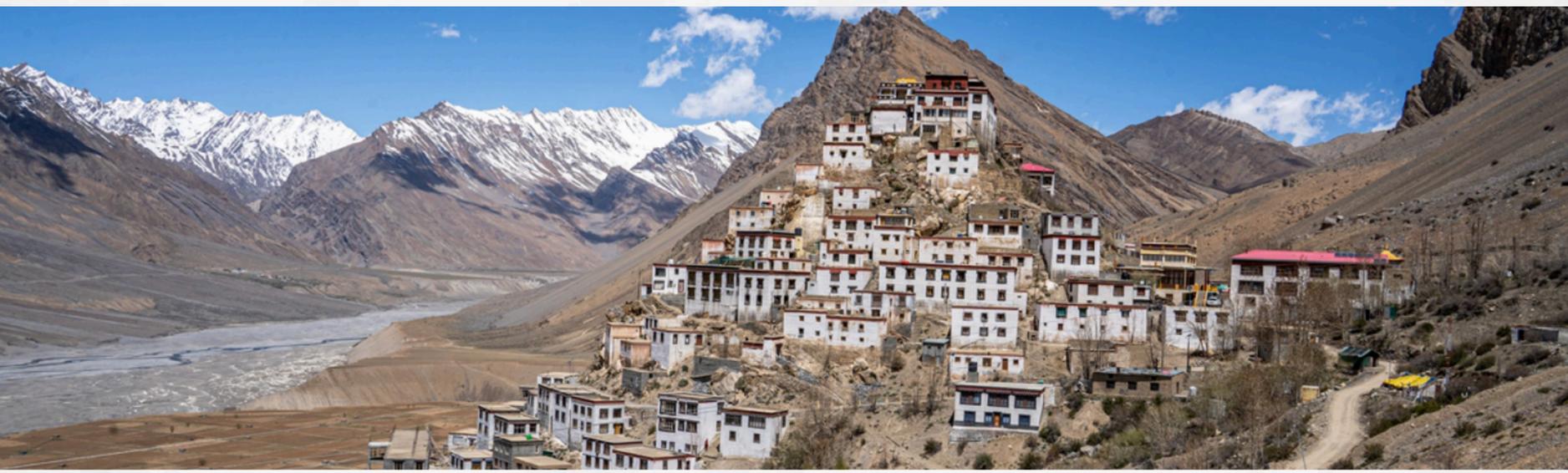
- Minimum age: 0 to 60 Years for most trips (infants 2+ for select family journeys).

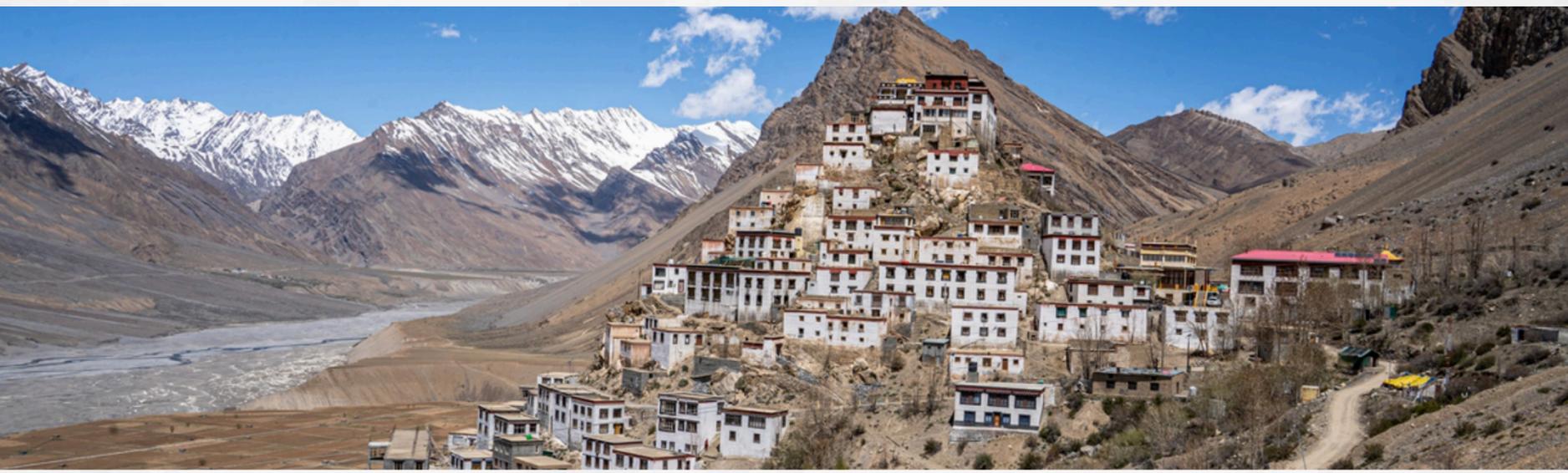
